

- 1. Begin with a 5 ½" x 8 ½" piece of <u>So Saffron cardstock</u>. That is then scored at 4 ¼" and folded in half.
- 2. Take a piece of 5 ½" x 4" <u>Sand and Sea Designer Series Paper</u> and adhere to card base using <u>Stampin' Seal</u> with a 1/8" border of the So Saffron on either side showing.
- 3. Take a 5 ½" x 4 ½" piece of <u>Sahara Sand cardstock</u> and using the <u>Stamparatus</u> stamp the seashell images in <u>Sahara Sand</u> onto the card stock so that they will line up with the images on the <u>Seashells 3D Embossing Folder</u> and the <u>Seaside Seashells Dies</u>.
- 4. Use the large die from the Seaside Seashells Dies and the <u>Stampin Cut & Emboss</u> Machine to die cut the shape.
- 5. Take the Die cut shape and line it up with the Seashells 3D Embossing Folder and run that sandwich through the Stampin' Cut and Emboss Machine.
- 6. Using the <u>Fine Tip Glue Pen</u> apply the adhesive to the back of the die cut and embossed image making sure to get adhesive on the small seaweed pieces to ensure they adhere and don't get caught.
- 7. Once all the glue is applied turn the die cut piece over and carefully line it up so the bottom of the die is at the bottom edge of the card.
- 8. Next stamp the sentiment from the <u>Friends Are Like Seashells Stamp</u> set in Sahara Sand on a piece of <u>Very Vanilla</u>.
- 9. Using a die of your choice and the Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine cut out the sentiment.



10. Using Stampin' Dimensionals adhere the sentiment to the card front in the lower left hand corner.



- 11. Now take a piece of Very Vanilla Cardstock cut to 5 ¼" by 4 ".
- 12. In the lower corners stamp the small seashell image from the Friends are Like Seashells Stamp set using a Clear Block. Stamp the image in Sahara Sand.
- 13. Using the Stampin' Seal adhere the stamped card stock to the inside of the card leaving 1/8" of the So Saffron showing as a border.



14. To add flare to the card place the Opal Rounds on the front of the card.
